Brembo confirms leader status of motorsport competitions in 2014 season

The Italian Company triumphs in all races of Formula One and MotoGP World Championships

Stezzano, Italy, December 2014 – Brembo, world leader in technology and production of brake systems and high performance automotive components, confirms again its technological supremacy through a string of great successes in competitive motorsport competitions during 2014 season.

The Italian Company has achieved '*en plein*' in Formula One, triumphing in all 19 races of World Championship, thanks to 16 victories reached by Mercedes AMG Petronas F1 Team, winner of Constructors World Championship, and 3 victories obtained by Red Bull Racing team.

In detail, 11 are the successes achieved by Lewis Hamilton (Mercedes AMG Petronas F1 Team), winner of Drivers World Championship, 5 the ones reached by Nico Rosberg (Mercedes AMG Petronas F1 Team) and 3 are Daniel Ricciardo's victories (Red Bull Racing).

Involved in Formula One since 1975, Brembo has reached a total of 20 World Championship Drivers' titles and 25 World Championship Constructors' titles divided in this way: 14 with Scuderia Ferrari, 4 with Red Bull Racing, 3 with McLaren Honda, 2 with Benetton Renault, 1 with Brawn GP and 1 with Mercedes AMG Petronas F1 Team.

We remind that in 2014 season the Italian Company has supplied brake systems to seven teams involved in Formula One: Caterham F1 Team, Infiniti Red Bull Racing, Mercedes AMG Petronas F1 Team, Sahara Force India F1 Team, Sauber F1 Team, Scuderia Ferrari and Scuderia Toro Rosso.

Total domination in two-wheel racing of MotoGP World Championship, as 12 of the 13 teams involved in the 2014 MotoGP season and 21 of the 23 riders have used Brembo brake systems fitted to their machines. Brembo has contributed to the second consecutive world title won by Marc Marquez with Repsol Honda team, achieved thanks to a total of 13 victories, while Honda team gained Constructors Title.

Brembo '*en plein*' was completed by 2 victories of Valentino Rossi (Yamaha Factory Racing), 2 successes of Jorge Lorenzo (Yamaha Factory Racing) and 1 win of Dani Pedrosa (Repsol Honda).

To confirm its leadership, the Italian Company has worked in close cooperation with the leading global manufacturers of cars and motorcycles, investing all-out commitment in research and development of highly innovative and technologically advanced products, able to guarantee high performances, maximum reliability and safety.

Brembo has created an interesting Infographic (*in attached*) that, in percentage way, compares the results achieved by the Italian Company in Formula One and MotoGP in 2014 season, based on 10 different indicators: wins, podiums, points, qualifying sessions, total laps, hat tricks, front row, laps in the lead, fastest laps and teams equipped with Brembo brakes.

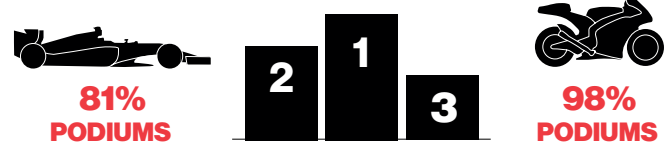

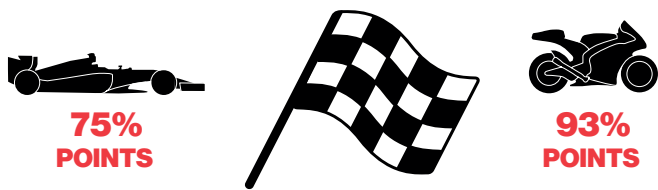
An infographic that compares results achieved by Brembo in F1 and MotoGP during the 2014, based on ten different indicators.



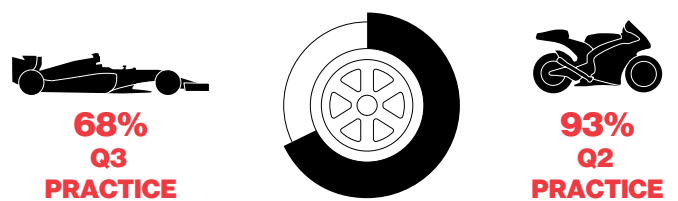
19 wins in 19 F1 races and 18 wins in 18 Moto GP races for the cars and motorcycles with Brembo brakes.



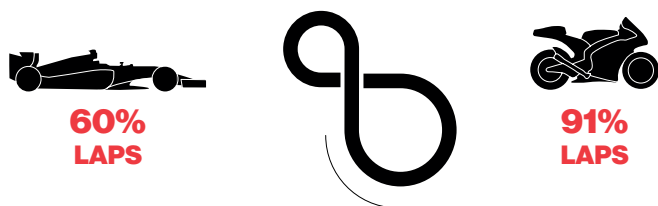
Of the 57 podiums available in the 2014 F1 season, 48 have gone to cars with Brembo brakes. Of the 54 podiums available in the 2014 MotoGP season, 53 have gone to bikes with Brembo brakes.



Of the 2020 points available in the 2014 Formula 1 season, 1507 were won by cars with Brembo brakes. In Moto GP, of the 2534 points available in the 2014 season, 2349 were won by bikes with Brembo brakes.



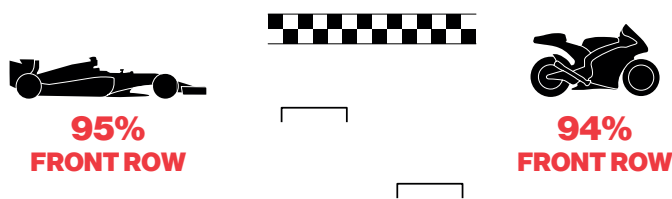
In F1, of the 190 cars that have achieved Q3 of qualification, 130 were equipped with Brembo brakes. In MotoGP, of the 216 bikes that have reached Q2 of qualification, 201 were equipped with Brembo brakes.



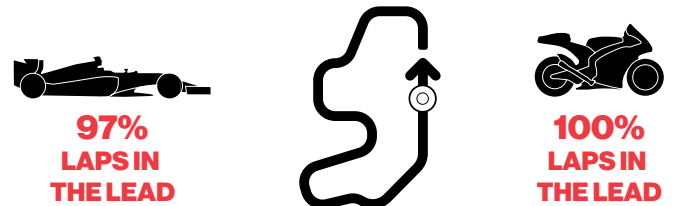
12,556 were the number of laps made by cars with Brembo brakes out of a total of 20979 laps throughout the 2014 Formula 1 season. There were 8346 laps made by motorcycle with Brembo brakes out of a total of 9202 laps during the 2014 season.



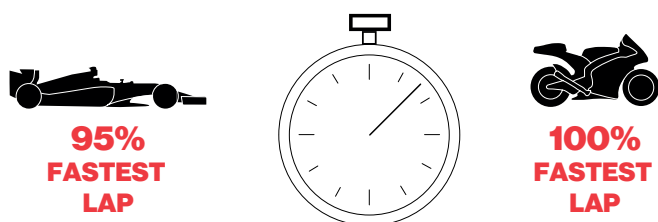
In 17 of the 19 races in the 2014 Formula 1 season, Brembo has scored the Hat Trick by equipping the cars that have won the pole position, the fastest lap and the victory in the same Grand Prix. In MotoGP, Brembo scored a Hat Trick in 17 of the 18 races.



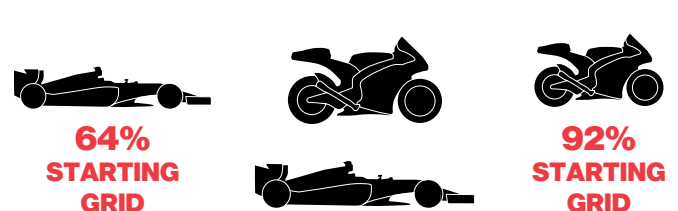
The front row of cars all comprising Brembo brakes in 18 of the 19 GP of the 2014 Formula 1 season. Front row of 3 bikes all comprising Brembo brakes in 17 of the 18 GP of the 2014 MotoGP season.



1099 of 1134 are the laps that saw the lead car with Brembo brakes in the 2014 season of Formula 1, while in the Motogp, all 476 laps saw a motorcycle with Brembo brakes in the lead.



A single-seater with Brembo brakes clocked the fastest lap in 17 of the 19 Grands Prix in Formula 1. A bike with Brembo brakes clocked the fastest lap in 17 of the 18 Grands Prix in Moto GP.



7 out of 11 teams use Brembo brakes in F1, 12 out of 13 teams in Moto GP.
