TARGET

ACTIONS

- Reduce marine pollution of all kinds, in particular from land-based activities.
- Promote a search for innovative solutions that protect marine ecosystems and biodiversity.
- Provide access for small-scale artisanal fishers to marine resources and markets.



THINGS WE CAN ALL DO

- Reduce waste and dispose of waste correctly.
- Avoid using single-use plastic bags or other plastic products.
- Use a refillable bottle instead of drinking from plastic bottles.
- Buy local, certified fish.

BREMBO'S COMMITMENT

CUT DOWN ON THE USE OF PLASTIC AND IMPROVE RECYCLING (STIZZANO, ITALY – FOLLOWED BY ALL THE OTHER SITES)

Responsible thinking and redefining the way we use plastic and waste in a circular solution are ideas that help to mitigate environmental pollution and climate change and manage resources sustainably while protecting ecosystems and biodiversity.



TARGET

- Reduce the use of single-use plastic in the company.
- Encourage sustainable recycling.
- Dispose of waste correctly.



ACTIONS

- Give all employees a Brembo refillable bottle.
- Install water dispensers and introduce paper coffee cups and wooden stirrers.
- Make the recycling areas more functional and improve final waste management.
- Introduce paper boxes which are shared by several work stations and only used for paper.
- Use only paper cups or glass tumblers, stainless steel teaspoons and eliminate straws from the canteen.
- Introduce glass bottles, carafes and glass tumblers for the catering service.
- Use paper containers for take away food.



RESULTS

- Reduction in the consumption of single-use plastic of approximately 4000 bottles only in Stezzano site.
- More sustainable management of resources and reduced waste.
- Correct disposal of different types of waste.
