# BREMBO'S COMMITMENT

## “DREAM CENTER”, QUALITY EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN IN RURAL AREAS (CHINA)

In the social and economic context of rural China, 61 million children in underdeveloped areas do not have easy access to quality education as well as 36 million children whose parents are migrant workers.

Brembo has sustained the NGO Adream's project by helping to redevelop two schools (Dream Centers) in the province of Anhui and on the outskirts of Shanghai.



### TARGET

- Guarantee quality education for the more disadvantaged children in the area and the children of migrant workers.
- Narrow the education gap between the cities and the countryside.



### ACTIONS

- Selecting and rebuilding classrooms in two existing schools.
- Defining a non-traditional teaching program which uses IT material with the aim of developing individual students' skills.
- Organizing a professional teaching course for the Dream Center teachers.



### RESULTS

- Setting up of two Dream Centers for 791 children of primary school age.
- Improvement of the educational system which aims to stimulate students' skills and aspirations.



# BREMBO'S COMMITMENT

## “HOUSE OF SMILE”, SOCIAL PROGRAM IN PUNE (INDIA)

Launched in collaboration with the NGO Cesvi, the “House of Smile” offers support to women and children who live in a state of extreme vulnerability. It consists of a service center hub situated in a building in Bibwedi and three educational centers for children and young people in the slum areas of Pune. The local humanitarian organization, Swadhar, is responsible for the services and coordinates the project.



### TARGET

- Help children to read and write and teach children from the age of three to adolescence.
- Protect childhood.
- Support and sustain women who live in fragile conditions and young mothers.



### ACTIONS

- Promoting schooling for young people and helping with studying.
- Teaching civic education and guidelines for healthy eating.
- Setting up a computer lab.
- Creating library areas to encourage reading.
- Providing psychological support, legal guidance, medical assistance and health care for women and young mothers.
- Organizing vocational courses for women (dressmakers, hairdressers, beauticians, etc.) that offer a recognized qualification.



### RESULTS

- Setting up of one hub and three educational centers that offer services to 486 children and 527 women on average each year.
- Development of level of schooling in some areas of Pune.
- Improvement of the social and mental conditions of women who live in a state of vulnerability.
