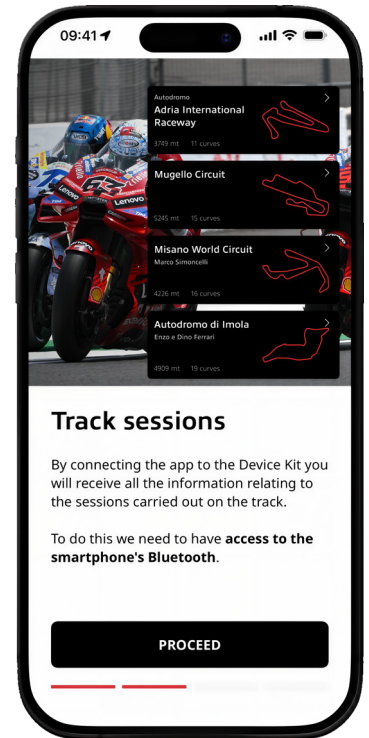

It all starts here. Download the app, create your account, pair the Device Kit and add your bike: a few steps to get the system ready to use.

DOWNLOAD THE APP



Download **TrackTribe** from your device's store (App Store or Google Play) and install it to get started. On launch you can sign in to your account or discover the bikes compatible with the system.

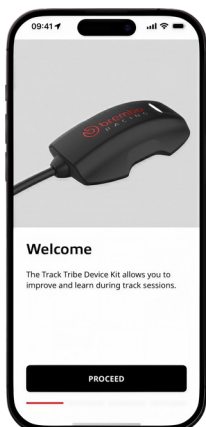
PART 01 · START-UP & REGISTRATION

Launch TrackTribe or discover the compatible bikes. A short intro tour shows how track sessions are recorded, how to review and learn from your data, and how to challenge the community.

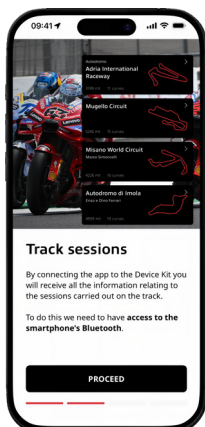
Then **sign in with your account** and verify your email to activate it. Complete your profile with name, surname, nickname and date of birth · your **nickname** will identify you in the leaderboards. To finish, **accept the Terms** and review the Privacy policy: you are now ready to start.

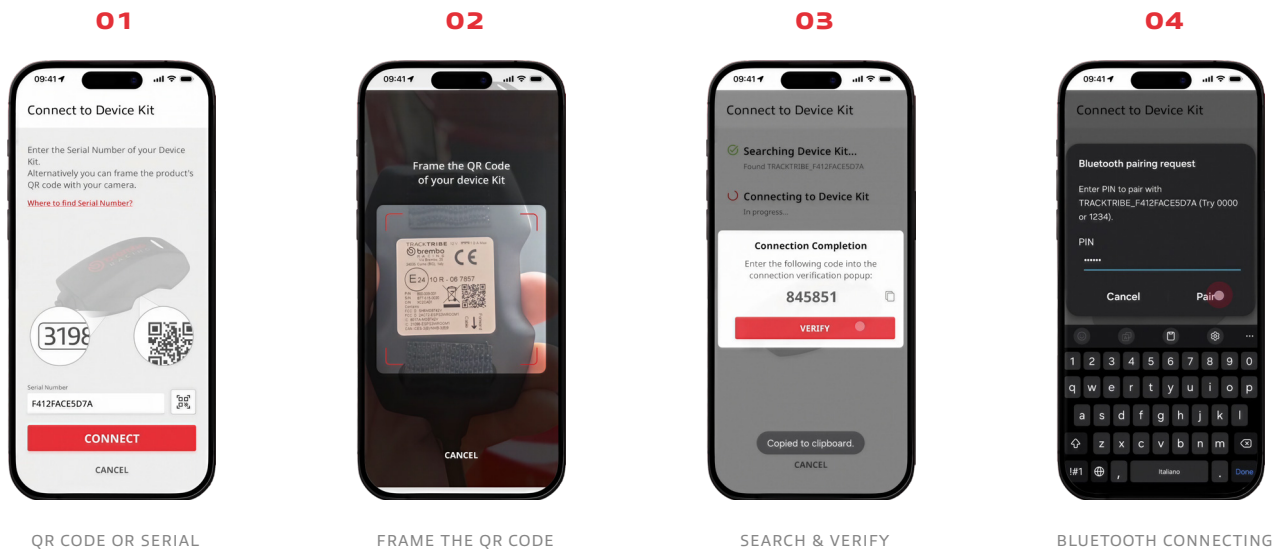
CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT

CONNECTING THE DEVICE KIT

Open the connection section and start **connecting** the Device Kit. Frame the QR code or enter the device's identification code.

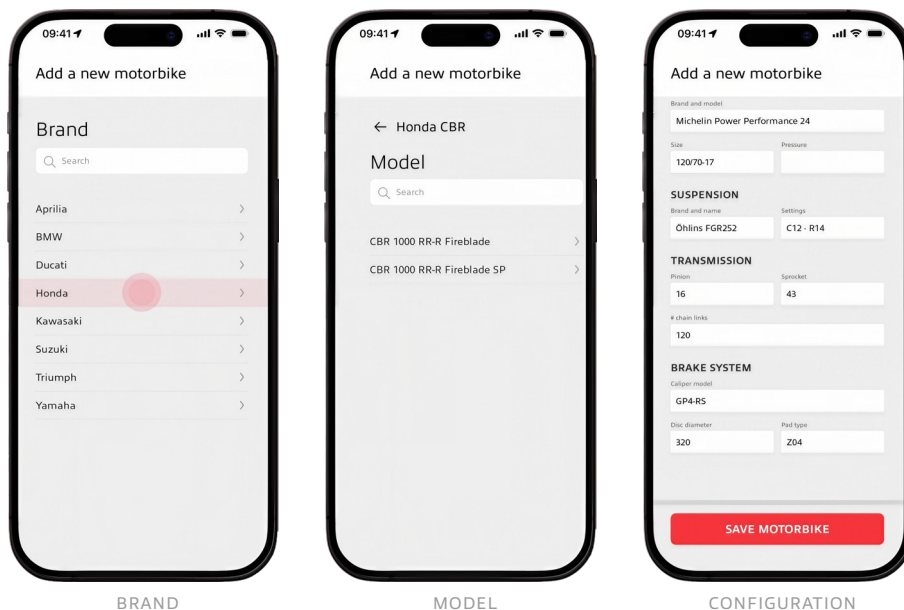
The app automatically searches for and connects to the Device Kit. Confirm the Bluetooth connecting request with the code shown.

Once the connection is complete, the device is correctly paired and ready to use. At the end you will be prompted to **add a bike** to start using the system.



ADDING YOUR MOTORBIKE

After completing the Device Kit connection · or directly from the app's home · you can add a new bike. Select **brand**, **family** and **model** from those available and proceed with the configuration of tyres, suspension, transmission and braking system.

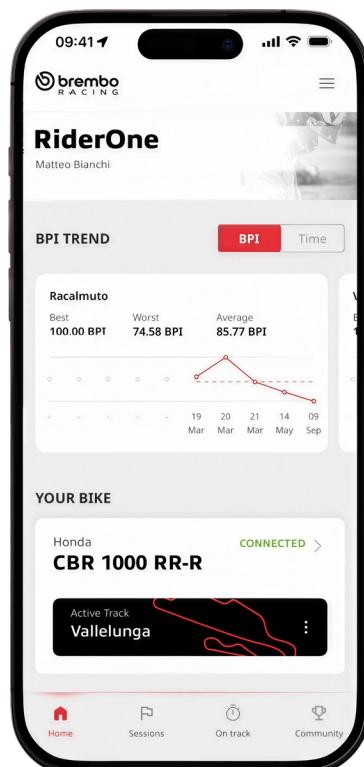

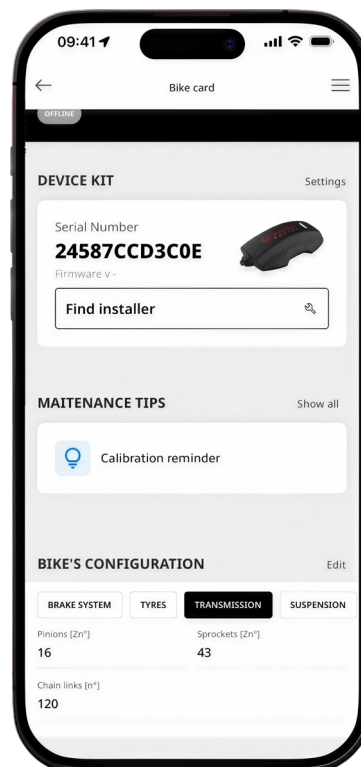
HOME · BIKE SETTING

To enter and manage your bike's characteristics, tap the various **tabs** to access the sections dedicated to the specifications.

You will always have your bike's **base configuration** available; for each session you can declare any changes you've made, so your data stays consistent and comparable over time.

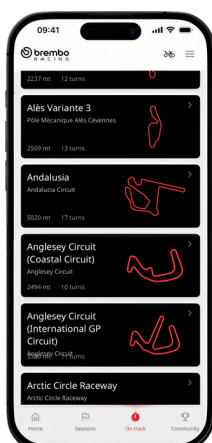
Select the circuit, activate it and ride. From the first flying lap the system automatically records your session and shows data in real time.

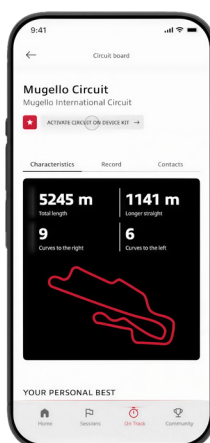
Open the "On Track" section, select the circuit where you intend to ride and · before actually entering the track · tap "activate circuit".

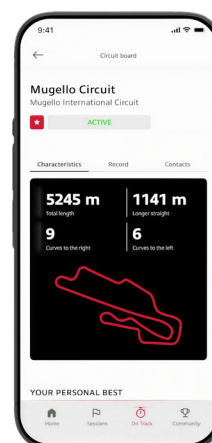

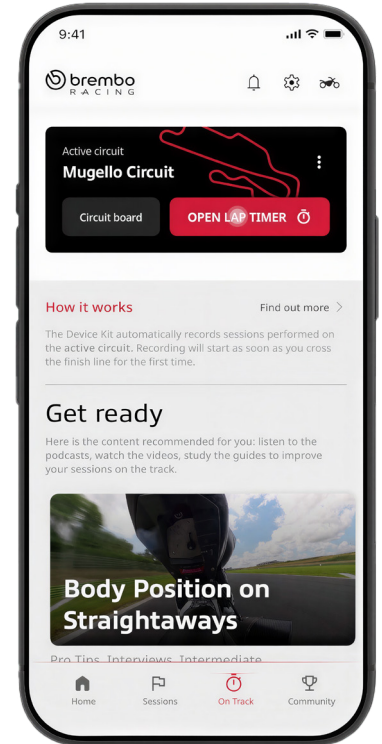
IMPORTANT · TRANSPORT MODE

The system is **not homologated for road use**. If you only use the bike on track, during transport set TrackTribe to transport mode by holding down the power button until the LED turns off: this prevents it from switching on with movement. Once at the circuit, switch the Device back on by holding the power button again.

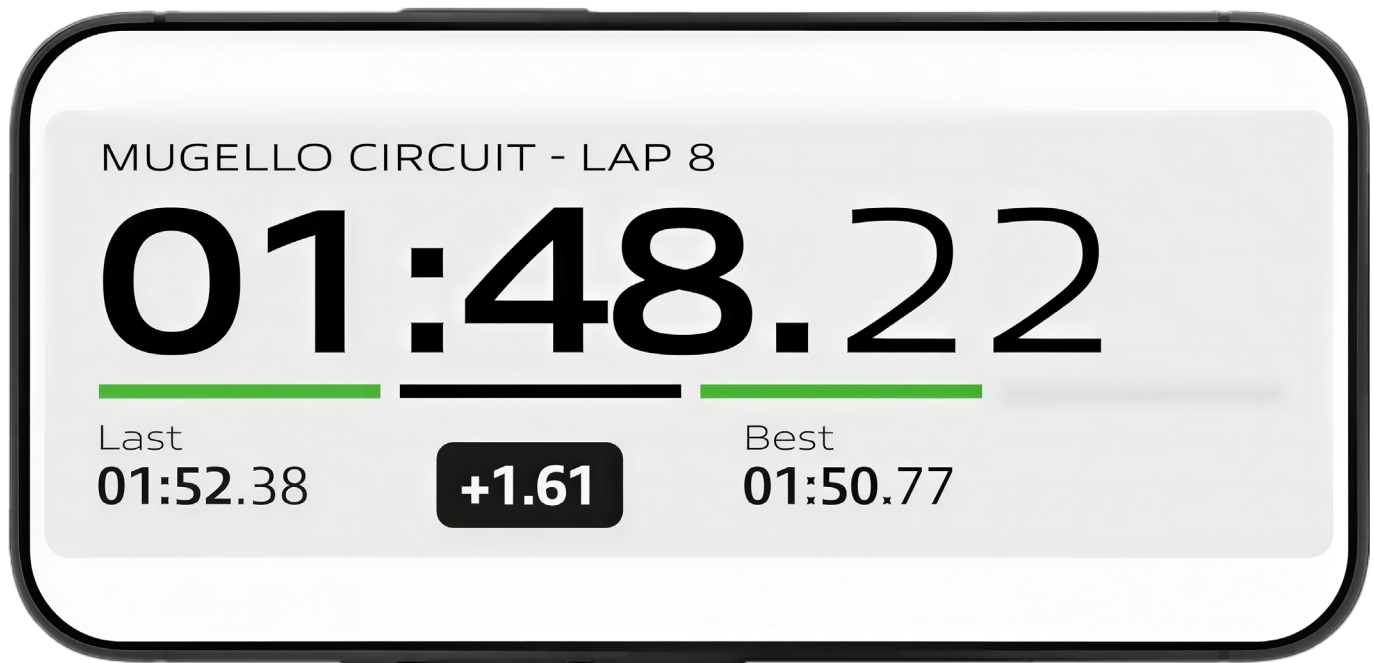
REAL-TIME DASHBOARD

Tap "open lap timer" to view real-time data while you ride.
The system works **only on circuits**, via geolocation.

After the first lap and once you have crossed the starting grid, the system begins **collecting data and recording the session automatically**. This way you can monitor all the information relevant to your performance from the very first actual lap.

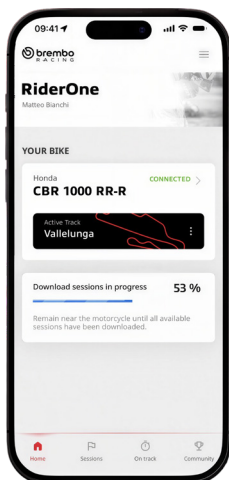

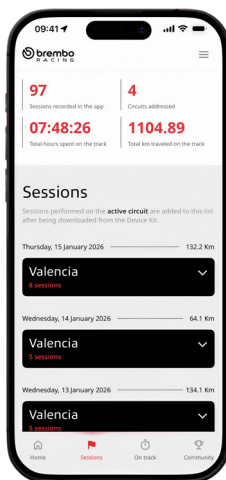

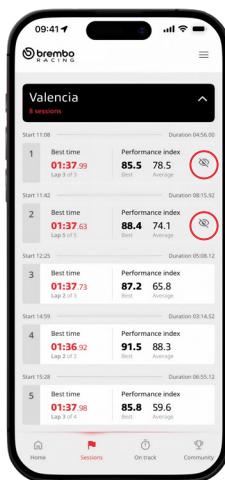
To review the data, select the reference **circuit**: you will find the track days ordered by date and, for each lap, the best time and the **Brembo Performance Index** value.



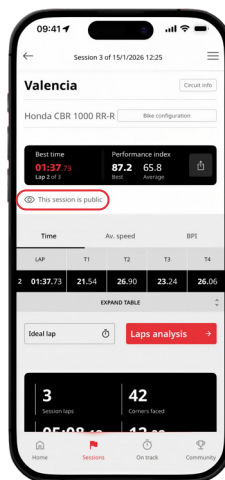

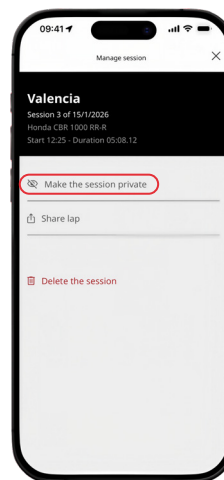
HISTORY BY DATE

PART 04 · SESSION PRIVACY

PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SESSIONS

During data download, in **"Home"**, you will find the option to make sessions public by tapping **"public session"**. If you prefer to keep them private, do not enable the option.

To check the status, look next to each session: the **closed-eye icon** indicates a private session, also shown inside the session itself. Alternatively, you can make a session public directly from the circuit page.

FEEDBACK & WEATHER

Before confirming a downloaded session, choose whether to make it **public**, rate how it went and **select the weather** conditions. You can also add a **personal note** to record any useful details about the ride.

If the bike setup was **changed** for this session, tap **"Edit motorcycle setup"** and update the **relevant settings**.

All this information is **saved with** the session, providing useful context when you review your **data and compare** your performance over time. Tap **"Confirm"** to save and continue.

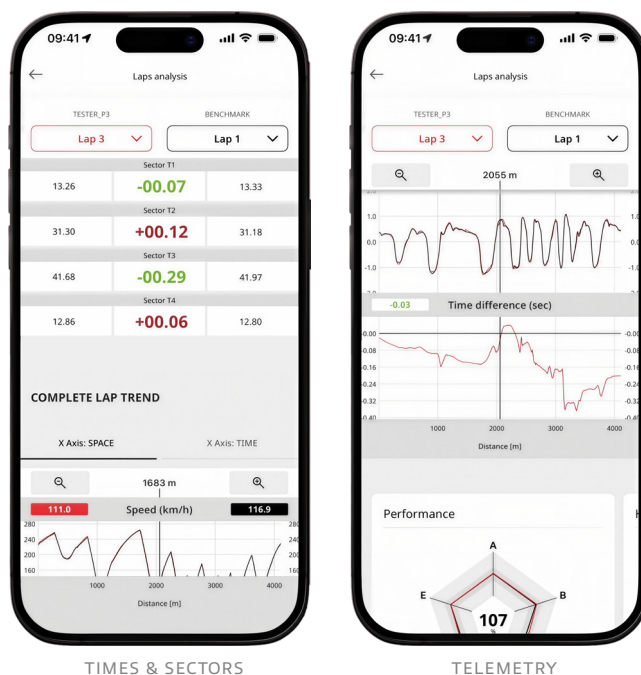
Lap time, splits, telemetry, BPI and replay: analyze every detail of your riding and compare yourself with your best laps or with other riders in the Community.

PART 05 · ANALYSIS 1/2

LAP TIME, SPLITS & BPI

Tap the chosen lap to view the **"Time"** table with lap time and splits (best ones highlighted), **"Average speed"** and your **"BPI"**.

In **"Lap analysis"** you can easily find improvement insights through the **"Complete lap trend"**: speed, brake pressure, lean angle, acceleration and time difference. With **"lap x"** (red section) you change the analyzed lap; with **"lap y"** (black section) you compare with your other laps or with riders in the Community.



BPI · BREMBO PERFORMANCE INDEX

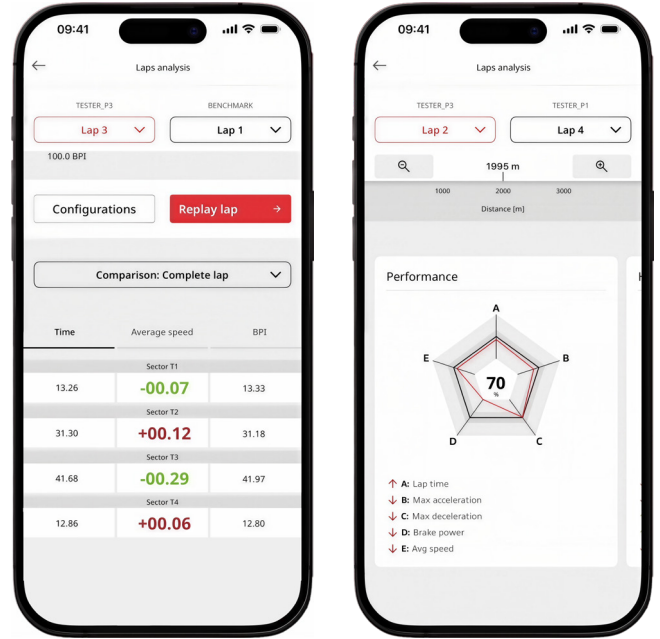
Based on algorithms derived from Brembo's experience in the MotoGP and WSBK championships, the BPI combines several indicators · lap time, speed, acceleration, deceleration and braking power · giving a clear view of your strengths and weaknesses. **The higher the index, the closer your riding is to racing excellence.**

STATISTICS & RADAR

Tapping the **magnifying glass** lets you examine in depth all the values of your performance, with a clear overview of the results.

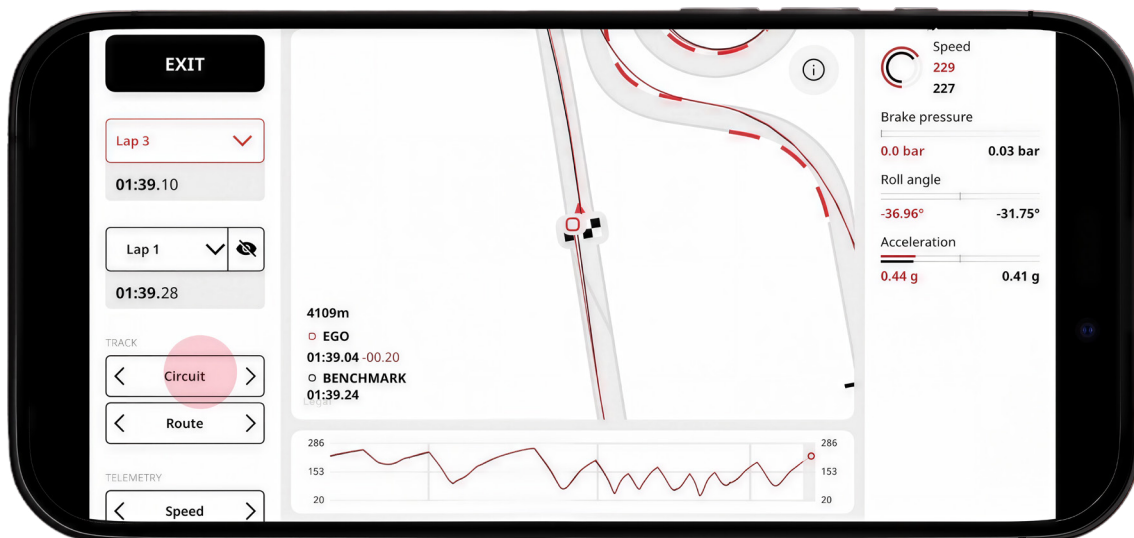
To make the comparison even more immediate and visual, **radar charts** are available showing performance, agility and braking ability.

With **"configurations"** you will find the setup of your bike and of the rider you are comparing with, for a more objective analysis.



LAP REPLAY · TRAJECTORY

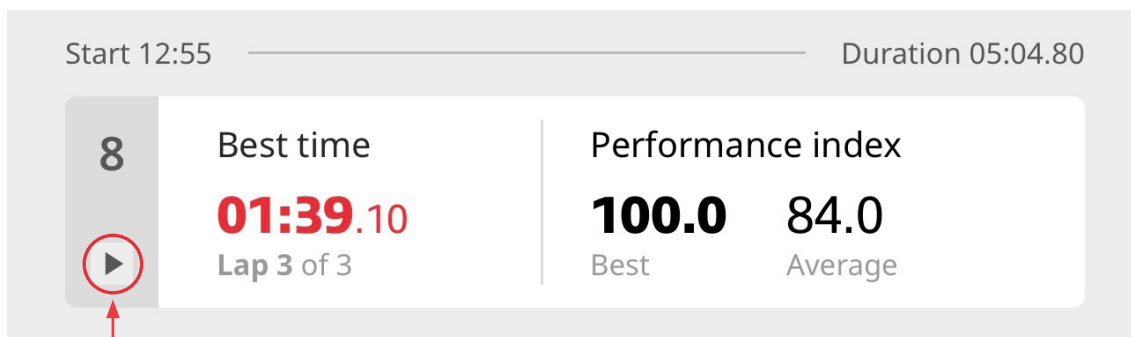
By selecting **"lap replay"** you view the trajectory taken and access detailed data: speed, braking, lean angle and acceleration. The view can be set by **space** or by **time**; zoom lets you examine each phase of the lap precisely. Using the red **"lap x"** tab or the black **"lap y"** tab you compare your performance with previous laps or with those of other riders; the **"trajectory"** and **"brakes"** tabs help you focus on specific track information.



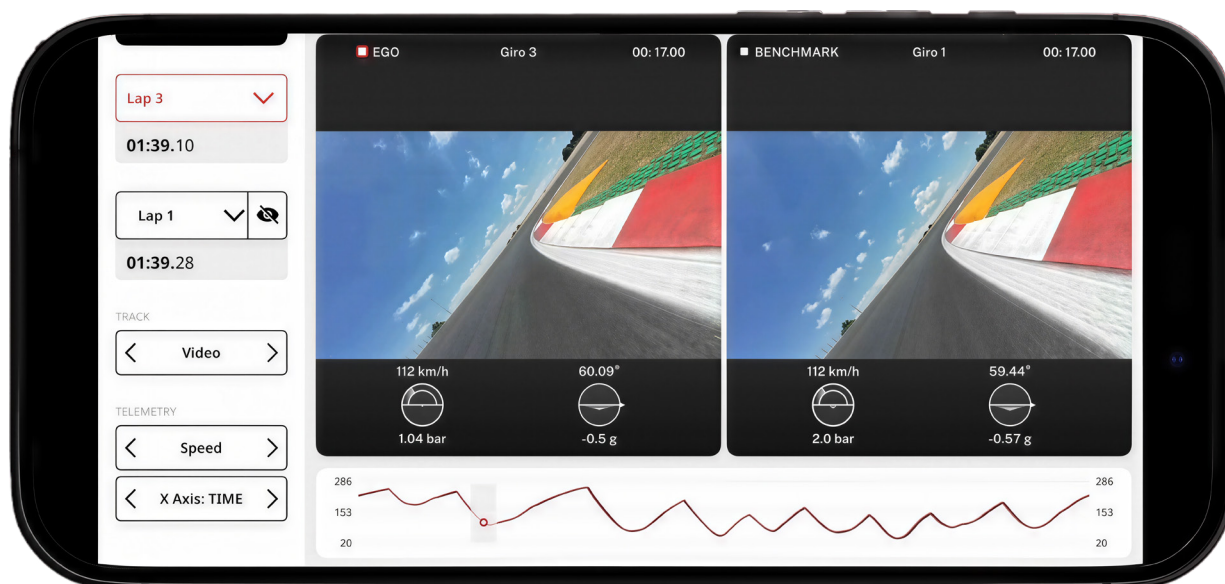
LAP REPLAY · TRAJECTORY AND TELEMETRY (LANDSCAPE VIEW)

SYNCED VIDEO & COMPARISON

Tapping "circuit" lets you select the video section and upload the recording of your lap to review it in the "replay" area (if an Action Cam is available). Your personal video is **synced with the telemetry data**, and side-by-side video comparison is possible.



The **Play** icon beneath the lap number indicates that a video is available for the session.

NOTE

Circuit start and end alignment must be done manually, trimming the first flying lap at the moment you cross the finish line.

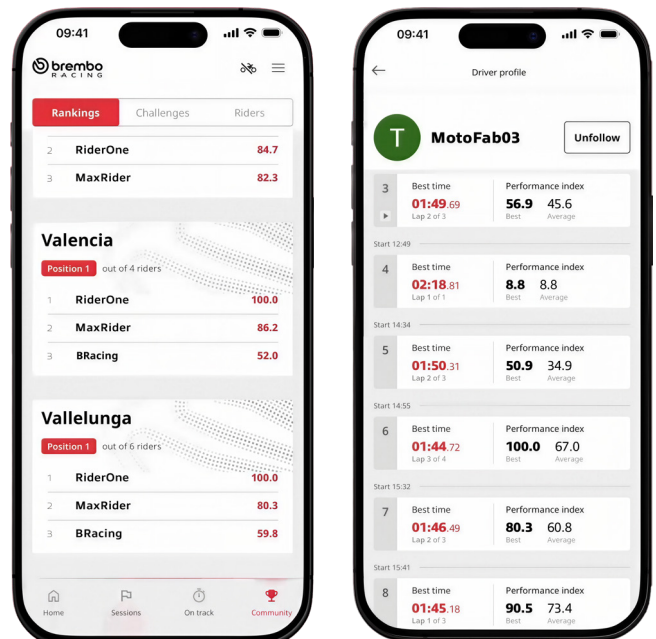
Measure yourself against other riders: leaderboards by circuit, profiles, head-to-head comparisons, and sharing of videos and infographics of your performance.

PART 06 · LEADERBOARDS & COMPARISON

COMMUNITY & SHARING

Tap the area dedicated to the **Community**: you will find all your public sessions ranked by **BPI** and time, on the circuits you have ridden. You see the leaderboards only for the circuits where you have ridden and made at least one session public.

With **"go to rider profiles"** you view the list of ranked riders; with **"compare"** you enter the chosen rider's reference lap to compare lap data.

SHARE YOUR PERFORMANCE

From the Community area you can share **videos** or **infographics** of your performance with friends, personalized with dedicated widgets: in **"On Track"** select the circuit of interest and tap **"share"**.

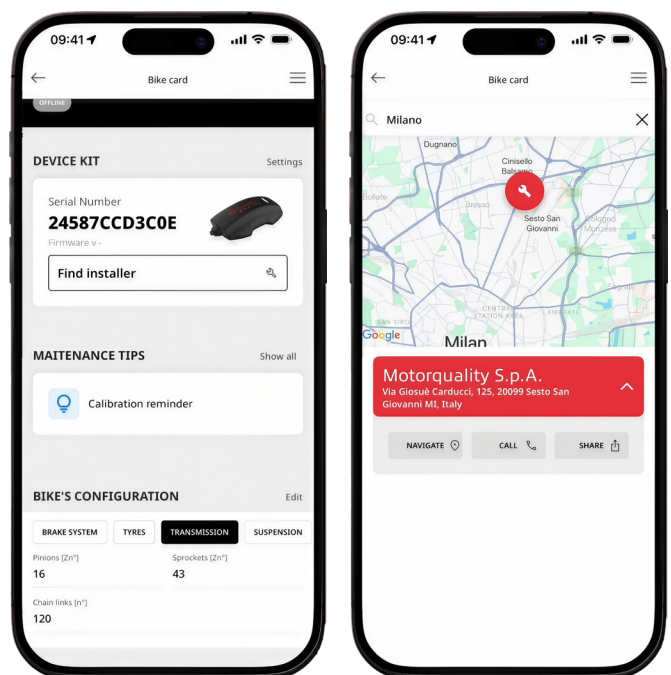
The home is your control centre. From here you manage your bike's characteristics, monitor your BPI trend and find the nearest authorized installer.

BIKE CARD & FIND AN INSTALLER

From the **bike card** you can check the Device Kit serial number and firmware, maintenance reminders, and navigate the bike configuration tabs · braking system, tyres, transmission, suspension.

"Add a bike" creates your bike's profile directly in the app: it is the starting point for all your future analyses, because it links every track session ensuring data that is always consistent and easy to compare.

For installation, tap "**find an installer**": quickly locate the nearest authorized installer and get professional support to make the most of every feature.

DEVICE LED MEANING

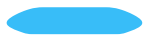
The device's LED communicates the system status through colour and blink type. Below is the meaning of the main states.

**PURPLE**

GPS not fixed

**GREEN**

GPS fixed

**LIGHT BLUE**

Phone connected to the device

**YELLOW**

Calibrating

**WHITE**

Power button pressed

**RED**

Error

TO COMPLETE

All the colours above with a **solid LED** indicate that the device is reading the CAN. A **glow** (slow blink) signals that the heart rate monitor is connected.
